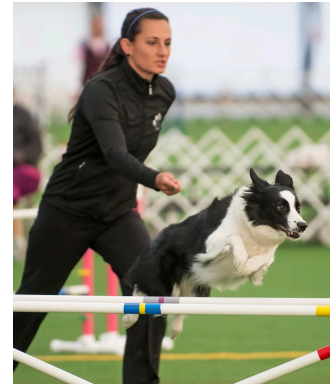

Either-Or Training

Dogs are masters in reading our body language, and they learn very quickly. If we repeat an exercise many times, they learn to anticipate what happens next. In this "Either - Or" workshop, you will learn to balance your training to strengthen your dog's understanding of your handling and improve your execution of the techniques in short sequences that show your dog how small differences can make a big impact. Appropriate for dogs sequencing at least 8-10 obstacles. Some familiarity with OneMind Dogs techniques will be helpful. Obstacles used are jumps and tunnels. Young dogs are welcome.

Front Cross vs Blind Cross

Learn when to choose a Front Cross or a Blind Cross and practice the two techniques in short sequences. Knowing when to choose the best technique for your dog will help your dog stay on the correct path all the time and advancing on the course will be easier and safer for your dog. Appropriate for dogs sequencing at least 8-10 obstacles. Some familiarity with OneMind Dogs techniques will be helpful. Obstacles used are jumps and tunnels. Young dogs are welcome.

Advanced Handling Solutions

Do you always end up choosing the same handling options on a course? Would you like to be pushed outside of your comfort zone and try different solutions? Learn to be creative in finding the handling that suits your team. Learn to recognize lines and technique options and to make the best decisions for you and your dog as a team for handling complex sequences within a course. In this seminar, teams will run sequences and test different handling strategies!

Dogs should be training or ready to train at the Masters level; OneMind Dogs experience is encouraged, but not required. Jumps and tunnels used, may include weaves and/or A-frame.

Working team requirements: All dogs must be dog and people friendly, and able to sequence 8-10 obstacles.

Familiarity with OMD techniques is helpful but not necessary.
