



Reporting A Covid Exposure or Positive Test

We rely on everyone to help keep members of our community safe. By choosing to enter our facility you must sign a waiver indicating that you understand the risks of training indoors with other people. We are doing everything possible to mitigate the risks of Covid-19 but we realize that there is a risk of possible exposure to the virus. Here are the steps that we are taking in the instance of a reported exposure or positive case:

If any student or instructor is experiencing covid like symptoms, has been alerted that they have potentially been exposed to Covid- 19, or receives a positive test result they are to follow these steps:

1. Report your status to your instructor, facilities@dtccc.org, or fill out this form: [DTCCC Covid Exposure Reporting Form](#) as soon as possible. Your identity will be kept completely confidential and we appreciate your assistance in protecting our community.
2. You will be asked to follow county health guidelines and stay home for at least 2 weeks from onset of symptoms or when approved to return to activities by a health official.

These are the steps that DTCCC will take following a reported case of potential exposure:

1. The Board will be notified
2. All students in the affected individual's class will be notified
3. The class will reconvene in person 14 days after test date
4. Regarding affected instructor's other active classes: instructors may choose to continue their classes via zoom, transfer classes to a substitute instructor, or wait 14 days to resume classes. All students will be notified of class format changes within 48 hours.
5. Positive cases will be reported to Chester County Health Department.
